

2022 Edelnet Summer School LL.B.

The EDELNet Partnership is delighted to announce that we are inviting applications to the annual EDELNet LL.B. Summer School that will take place this year from **11 to 15 July 2022 in Bonn (Germany)***.

*(*Pandemic issues could involve modifications on the initial Program planning, which would be announced with time in advance).*

As in previous years, 30 students from the FernUniversität Hagen (Germany), the Open Universiteit (Netherlands), UNED (Spain) and Open University (UK) will meet at a wonderful location in the EU and have the opportunity to work together in a series of activating seminars and simulations designed to offer a high quality learning experience and gain insight into legislative processes, rule of law operations and other vital aspects of legal systems in liberal democracies. In addition, participants will get a valuable chance to have a meaningful exchange with students and instructors from other European jurisdictions in an institutionally supportive and intellectually challenging environment.

The programme begins with *an online preparatory phase* in April during which participants are expected to take a few short online courses. Structured around the professional processing of hypothetical case simulations, *the face-to-face part* of the programme will focus on the performance of legal professional tasks to help students become aware of the intricacies of the real operation of law in practice and learn how to argue using the language of the law in different legal contexts. In the course of the programme you will receive well-structured and intensive training not only in legal matters, but also in soft skills such as academic debate, legal English, intercultural communication and team work.

Successful applicants are expected to be registered as LLB students at one of the organizing institutions and have a good command of English. Applications will be accepted **until 8 February 2022.**

Applicants must send an email with the CV and cover Letter in english for enrollment in the Summer School.

The Coordinator Team in Uned (Prof. Eva M. Domínguez Pérez; Prof. Juan Cruz Alli-Turrillas) will select students according to academic criteria (CV and cover Letter).

Successful applicants are expected to be registered as LLB students at one of the organizing institutions and have *a good command of English*.
