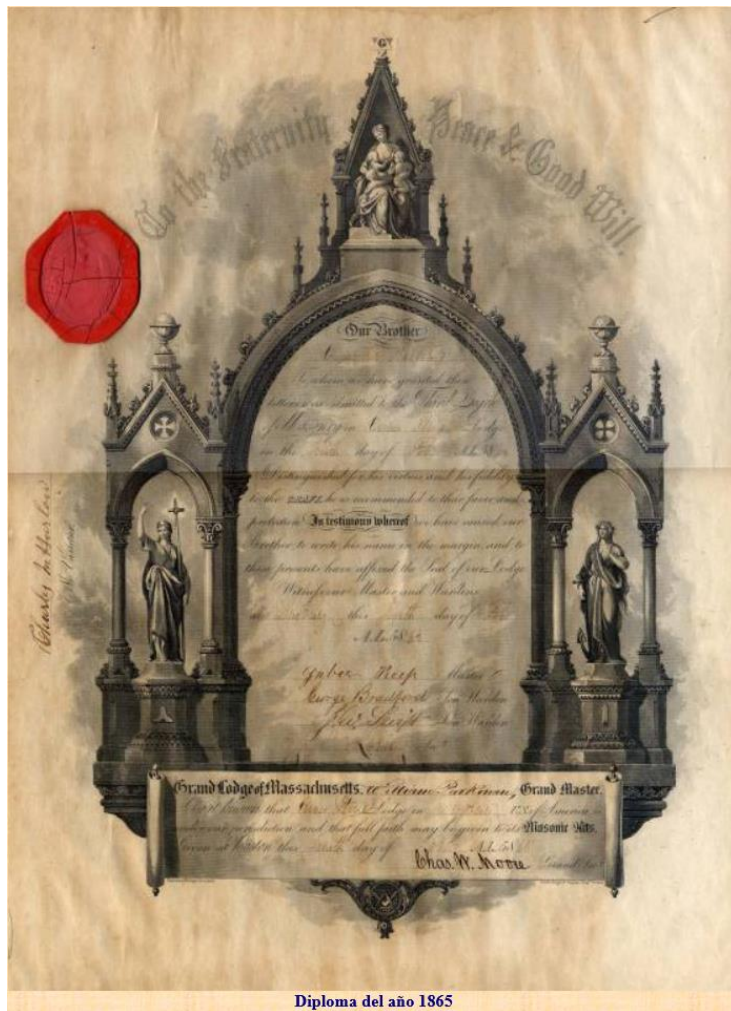

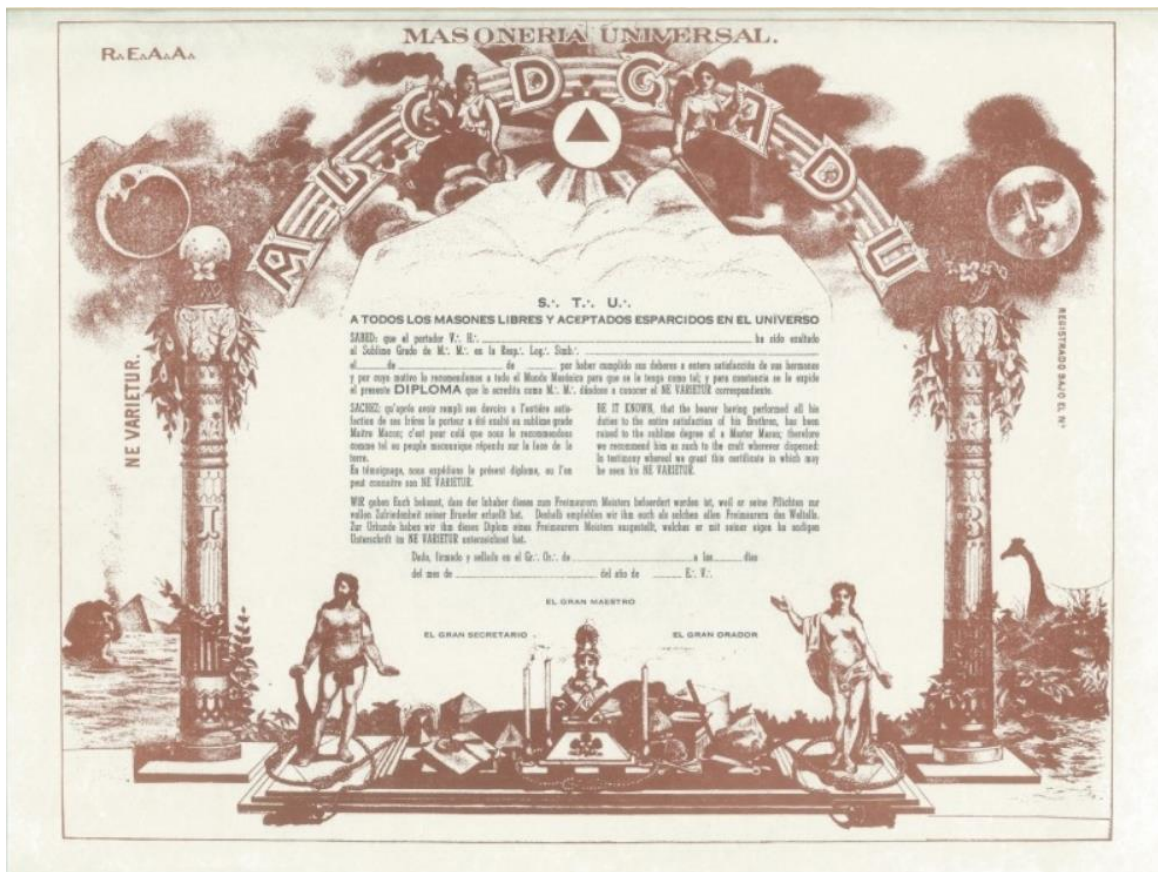
Diploma de la logia n° 234 de Londres, año 1805

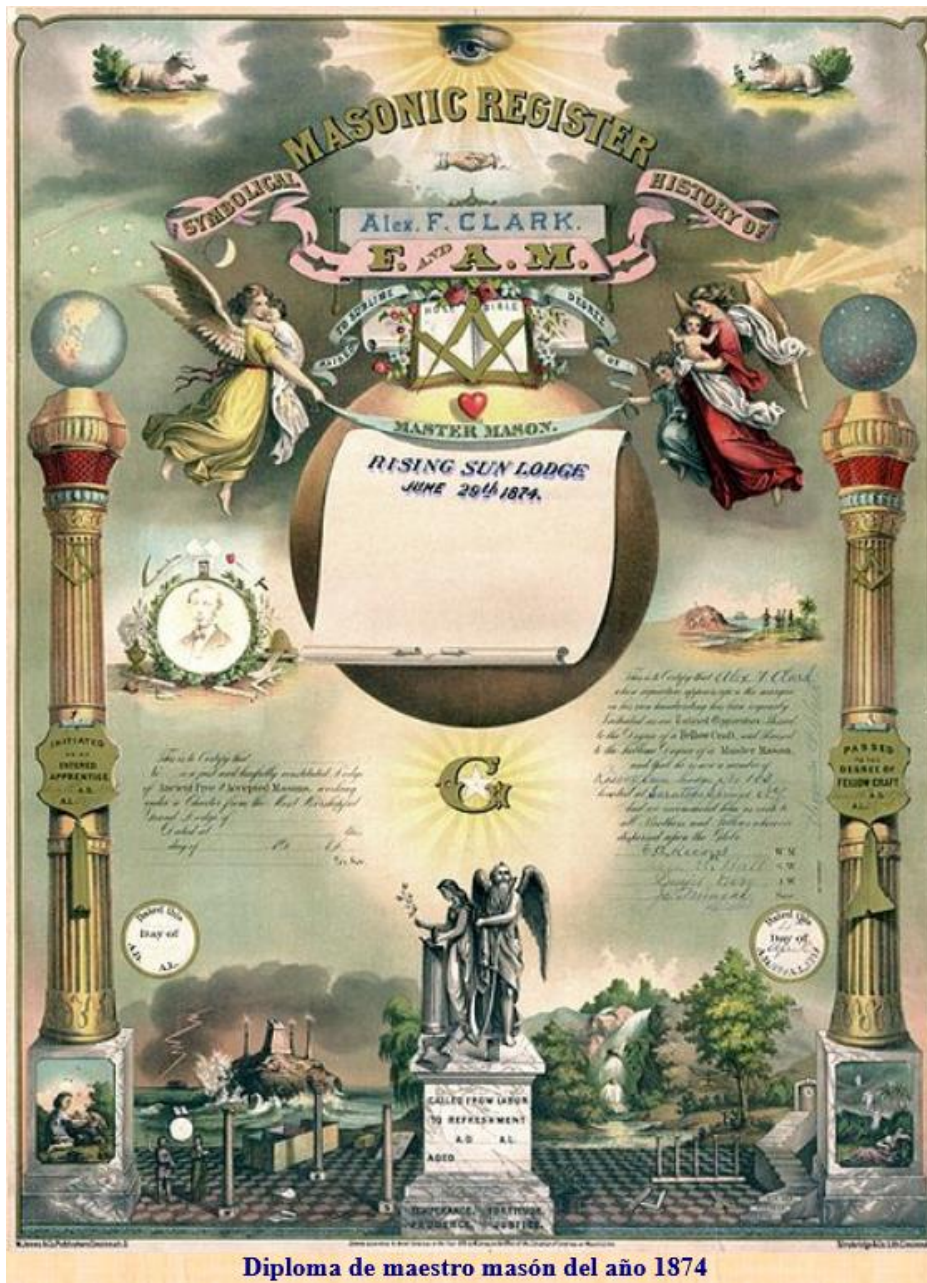

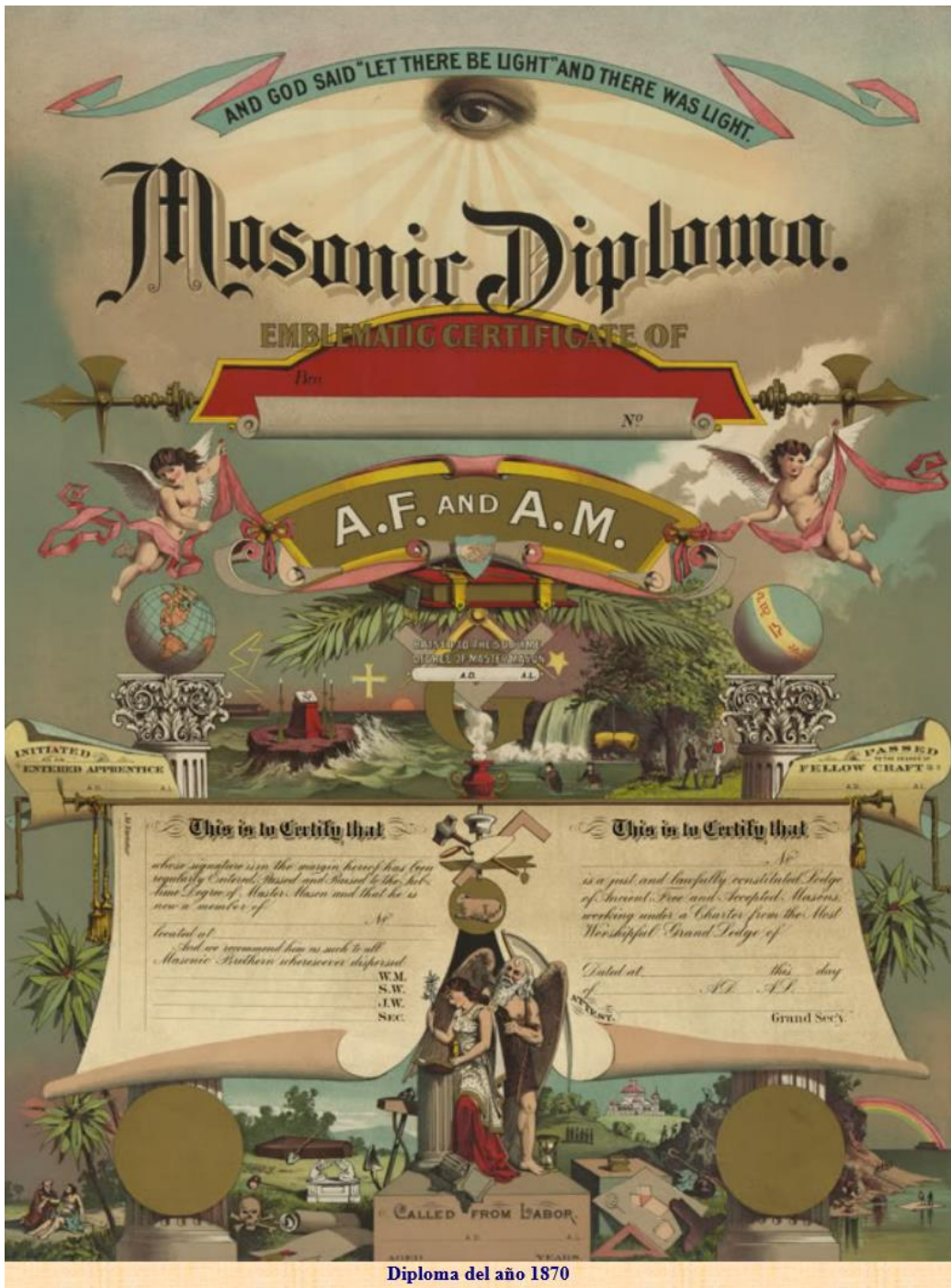


Diploma del Supremo Consejo del Grado 33
