## PRESENTACIÓN

Con el foco puesto en el análisis de diferentes variables vinculadas con la justicia social, la investigación en ACTS se organiza en varias áreas clave:

1. Estudio de los factores que impulsan o inhiben la participación en acciones colectivas desde una triple perspectiva: género, clase social y etnia.
2. Delimitación de las consecuencias psicosociales de la desigualdad socioeconómica.
3. Descripción de los procesos que llevan a la deshumanización de las personas en situación de pobreza y el desarrollo de actitudes clasistas.
4. Medición y cambio de actitudes relacionadas con comportamientos con consecuencias ambientales y su relación con aspectos como la justicia climática.

Nuestro objetivo es contribuir al entendimiento y transformación de los procesos sociales, proporcionando conocimientos y herramientas para promover una sociedad más equitativa y ecológicamente responsable.
